CHSP & CTP FEE SCHEDULE EFFECTIVE FROM 1st April 2025

Northern Illawarra Neighbour Aid Inc. (NINA) provides subsidised meals, social support and transport services to eligible participants of the following government-funded health and community service programs:

- Commonwealth Home Support Program (CHSP)
- Community Transport Program (CTP)
- Home Support Packages (HCP)
- National Disability Insurance Scheme (NDIS)

For CHSP and CTP clients, NINA receives Government grants directly and these fees are a client contribution. This includes clients that have CHSP referrals from My Aged Care and receive an HCP. For prices for clients on HCP & NDIS, contact the office for a fee schedule.

The different funding arrangements make it necessary for NINA to set different client fees among these programs, in order to recover operating costs which, exceed direct Government funding. The applicable fees are set out in the schedules that follow, first within group services and then individual services. The schedules are a guide to fees. Actual fees may vary in individual funding circumstances and in cases of financial hardship, which should be discussed with the Manager.

GROUP SERVICES

Meals at Café Club locations are at a standard rate to take in NINA providing across the board average price with a subsidised rate and including morning teas.
